The Erasmus + UPB office organized the long-awaited traditional event, "Erasmus + Open Doors Day" on March 10, 2022

In the European Year of Youth, the ERASMUS program celebrates 35 years of existence in Europe and 25 years in Romania. As we reach this age, the program comes with new opportunities for students:

- Mixed mobility, in which the period of physical mobility is complemented by a virtual component facilitating online collaboration and teamwork;
- Placement mobility with research assistance activities for students and PhD students that can be carried out in any relevant research center;
- Possibility to participate in several mobilities;
- 12 months cumulated per study cycle.





On 16 March 2022, with the support of the President of Romania, His Excellency Mr. Klaus Werner Iohannis, we placed the cornerstone of the House of Francophonie in Romania, the second such project in the world.

The House of Francophonie in Romania aims to become a regional cultural hub that will increase the mobility opportunities of francophone students and researchers. The project will provide young people around the world with quality housing and international events on the country's largest student campus.

Between March 12 -19, 2022, the Polytechnic University POLITEHNICA of Bucharest hosted the first edition of the Athens Program, which was attended by over 20 students from prestigious European universities, and gave advanced lectures on Biopolymers and Biocomposites.

ATHENS (Advanced Technology Higher Education Network, Socrates) aims to facilitate the exchange of students between major European technology universities (BME Budapest, KU Leuven, IST Lisbon, UPM Madrid, PM Millano, TUM Munich, CTU Prague, AUT Thessaloniki, NTNU Trondheim , TU Vienna, WUT Warsaw, ITU Istanbul, ParisTech).

The Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie – Central and Eastern Europe and the University POLITEHNICA of Bucharest are organizing the Festival of Francophone Students from Central and Eastern Europe, on July 11–15, 2022 in Bucharest, Romania.

Organized on the occasion of the European Year of Youth – 2022, the Regional Festival of Francophone Students brought together young Francophones from all over the Central and Eastern Europe region for a week. The diversity of workshops offered to participants will create exchanges of young students: starting from workshops on soft skills (the press article and the creation of audio podcasts) and up to artistic workshops, such as dance, painting/photography, music and sports. A gala evening and award ceremony for the finest talents and the best contributions by students will crown the 5 days of this festival dedicated to French-speaking youth in Central and Eastern Europe.

University POLITEHNICA of Bucharest was present at the #Romania Pavilion from # Expo2020Dubai with 5 projects that use unique technological methods. Thus, the visitors of the "New Nature" pavilion discovered:

 ${\mathscr V}$ the "Sounds of Vision" project that aims to help visually impaired people and the blind to interact with the environment, transforming images into sound and haptic information.

 ${\mathscr O}$ the "Prevent" project which aims to develop innovative solutions to reduce the transmission of airborne pathogens (such as COVID-19) as well as nosocomial infections.

✓ the CyberNotes application that aims to enrich and enhance the act of reading.

✓ the WateRo project created especially for the Romanian Pavilion, comprising a beautiful collection of almost 100 panoramic videos, 360 type videos with Romanian waters, ranging from the smallest mountain streams, waterfalls, to the Danube and the Black Sea.

✓ the Pronounce project, a pronunciation game of Romanian words structured on 3 degrees of difficulty (easy, medium and advanced), designed to promote the learning of the Romanian language.





Researchers at the university presented the latest research projects and developed technologies, as well as elements of medical engineering infrastructure.


